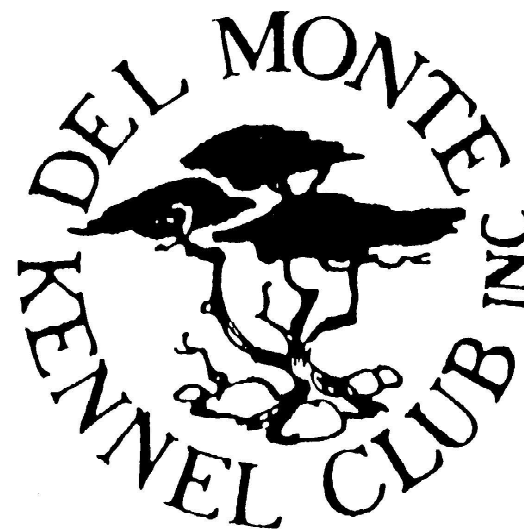

### Method of Entry:

Limited Trial - First Received - Limit 330 Total Runs per Trial.

Paper entries received within the first 24 hours of opening date and time must include postage or be metered. Entries must be delivered by multi-state or multi-national postal or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS, and DHL. A maximum of 10 entries per envelope is allowed. Entries may not be accepted or canceled after the closing date. NO Fax entries accepted. NO Online entries accepted. All fees must be paid in U.S. funds only. Minimum charge of \$25 for all returned checks.

Signed Entry Form must still be delivered to the Trial Secretary (via email). Entry is not complete until both a signed Entry Form AND Payment are received. The EMail entry method represents an express delivery mechanism for a traditional entry form rather than an online entry system. Online Payment refund for withdraw prior to closing for full entry amount less the 10% processing fee.

### Dogs Eligible to Enter:

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number (in trials allowing mixed breed entries) must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs disfigured as the result of accident or injury but otherwise qualified shall be eligible provided that the disfigurement does not interfere with functional movement. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible. Blind means without useful vision. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged or in any way has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Deaf dogs are eligible to participate.

Bitches in season are ineligible to participate.

### Bitches in Season:

Bitches in season are ineligible to compete, and may be withdrawn with full refund until the trial closes. After closing there will be a \$10 processing fee and the withdrawal request must be received in WRITING no later than one half hour prior to the first class of the day.

### Move-Ups:

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class as a result of completing a title.

Move-Ups requests prior to the trial must be received by 6:00 PM of the Monday preceding the event.

Saturday, Sunday move-ups will be allowed for dogs completing a title on Friday, Saturday. A form must be filled out and presented to the Trial Secretary within 15 minutes of the last run of the day for the following days..

### Prize Ribbons & Awards:

Ribbons will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place dogs with qualifying scores in each jump height.

All dogs receiving a qualifying score will be awarded a green qualifying ribbon.

### Show Site:

This show will be held at a York School in Monterey. Please follow all parking instruction and regulations. Limited overnite RV and Tent camping is permitted at the show site - fill out the attached reservation form and submit to the Trial Secretary with entry.

### Trial Hours:

7:00 am to 6:00 pm. Judging begins at 8:00 am.

### Rings:

The shows will be held outdoors on grass. A two ring setup will be used. Both rings will be 120 ft x 120ft.

### Running Order:

Running Order will be determined after closing.

### Obstacles

Obstacles will conform to current requirements of the AKC Agility Regulations.

### Course Familiarization

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course (without a dog) prior to the start of the class. The walk through is restricted to handlers entered in that class. A warm-up jump will be provided for each ring.

### Safety:

By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

### Vendors Welcome:

Appropriate vendors are welcome, contact Show Chairman for details.

## Notice to Exhibitors

Please TYPE or CLEARLY PRINT all information on the entry form. The Club assumes no responsibility for a wrong entry.

The club reserves the right to remove any dog should the circumstances warrant.

Dogs must be on leash at all times, except when in the ring.

Handlers must wear shoes while in the ring, No barefoot handler runs will be allowed.

Running order will be determined by a random draw. Handlers with more than one dog in a class will have those dogs separated as much as possible.

Request for withdrawal of entry must be made in writing. There will be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date, except for withdrawals for bitches in season. In the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition there will be no refund, regardless of the reason for dismissal.

The Club may cancel this event in extreme weather conditions.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee

No awards will be mailed or delivered.

The Club and Management will attempt to exercise every precaution for the safety of all dogs and people, however neither the Club nor the Management will be responsible for any injury or loss.

Early arrivals should respect sleeping residents by monitoring noise levels, keeping dogs under control, and quieting excessive barking.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site.

There is limited shade in the vicinity of the ring, please bring shade and water for yourself and your dogs.

**No Alcoholic Beverages** are allowed on the grounds.

This is a SELF CLEANING show. Please clean up after your dogs.

**DMKC will help York School maintain its commitment to being "green" by making filtered water in large carboys available free of charge. Just bring your own reusable containers for you and your dog!**

### From Bay Area

Take Hwy 101 south to Prunedale.

At Exit 336 take ramp right for CA-156 West toward Monterey Peninsula.

CA-156 becomes Hwy 1 South - continue following toward Monterey.

At Exit 401B, take ramp right for Hwy 68 East toward Salinas.

Follow Hwy 68 East toward Salinas approx 4 miles to York Road.

Turn Left onto York Road.

York School is at the top of the hill on your right.

### From Southern CA

Take Hwy 101 north to Salinas.

At Exit 326C take ramp right - Monterey Peninsula / Sanborn Road exit.

Follow Sanborn Road (becomes Blanco) approx. 2.5 miles to Main St.

Turn Left onto Main St (Hwy 68).

Follow Hwy 68 (Main St) approx. 10 miles to York Road.

# **AKC Class Changes Effective January 1, 2020**

## **Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend**

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend.

For example, the same dog may now be entered in Regular FAST and/or T2B to finish up those titles while also entered in Preferred Master STD/JWW to start working towards their PACH at the lower height.

Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed.

Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

## **Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day**

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day.

For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

When calculating entry fees, treat multiple entry forms for the same dog as if only one form had been filled out. In other words, the 1st run entry fee is only paid once per day, per dog, even if that dog's runs have been submitted on multiple entry forms.

## 2021 Updates

### Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

- For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only allowed in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.
- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).

### Fix and Go On (FNG)

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

## Jump Height Divisions

Owners are responsible for entering their dog in the proper height division.

REGULAR	PREFERRED	HEIGHT AT WITHERS

Jump height cards are no longer required to be submitted with the entry form.

If the dog needs to be measured, it is the handler's responsibility to ensure that the box on the entry form is checked indicating that the dog needs to be measured prior to running.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

### INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or *back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine Partners Program<sup>SM</sup>** may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

**Junior Handlers** should enter their Junior Handler Number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
